## **Bountiful Elementary Community Council Meeting October 4, 2018**

- 1- Boundary study going to board in a public hearing on October 16
  - a. Community council discussed the impact boundary changes would have on Bountiful Elementary.
  - b. Bountiful needs to have 40% free and reduced lunch students to be considered Title One. We are currently around 30% and would need to see a major change in boundaries from other areas (not Valley View) to affect that percentage.
  - c. Bus routes would also be impacted. We currently have 16 students eligible for bussing. If that number drops below 10, students in the Bountiful boundary east of Valley View boundary would be ineligible for bussing.
  - d. The recommendation to the school board is to take the boundary east of Davis Boulevard, which is currently in Bountiful, and move it to Valley View and assign all new students to Valley View. Courtesy bussing would remain in place only for the current 16 students.
- 2- Vote in new secretary
  - a. Andrea Hebdon will continue as secretary.
  - b. Rob Openshaw and Rebecca Cushing will continue as Chair and Vice Chair.
- 3- Next month's meeting will be moved to Thursday, November 8.
- 4- DIBELS test results (includes PALs classes)
  - a. K- 71% of students tested at or above benchmark
  - b. 1st- 51% of students tested at or above benchmark
  - c. 2<sup>nd</sup>- 80% of students tested at or above benchmark
  - d. 3<sup>rd</sup>- 79% of students tested at or above benchmark
