## **Bountiful Elementary Community Council Meeting May 23, 2019**

- 1. Review and approve April minutes
  - a. April minutes were approved.
- 2. Report on inclusion of Washington Elementary students
  - a. Will choose HOPE squad next year in order to include Washington elementary students in the process
  - b. Elena King will head up the SEM student council
  - c. Proposal to ask for Washington parents' input on transitioning to Bountiful
  - d. Bountiful will be getting around 60-65 students from Washington
- 3. TSSA money for the current year/next year
  - a. Hired a structured recess aide to help provide students who have behavior issues at recess with tools to interact successfully with others
  - b. HOPE squad will help with games at recess.
- 4. TSSP 2019-2020
  - a. Bountiful received about \$100 per student
  - b. Generally used at the discretion of the principal
    - i. Asked for teacher input
    - ii. Decided to focus on student engagement and student social and emotional needs
    - iii. Measurement plan goals are to show a 10% increase in students reporting that they feel safe at school and 3% increase for MOY test scores
    - iv. Increase the overall score on the state school report card by 1% over the prior year
    - v. Teachers will receive another contract day for preparations
    - vi. Professional coaching for teachers and staff as well as substitutes for teachers during training
    - vii. Structured recess aide and a behavioral tracking software (SWIS)
    - viii. Hiring an additional teacher to help reduce class size-adding a first grade teacher
    - ix. Third grade will get an aide to help with large class sizes
    - x. Stipends for staff members who read an assigned book and learn how to respond in TEAMS-a communicating software tool

- xi. Material and items for the mindfulness room-a room for students with anxiety to practice breathing and relaxation techniques
- xii. Stipends for teachers for implementing Nearpod software
- xiii. SWIS software to track student behavior
- 5. Meeting times for community council
  - a. Will get input from school psychologist and Washington community council to decide on a good meeting time for the 2019-2020 school year
- 6. Next year's flag ceremony
  - a. Discussed making changes to beginning of the year flag ceremony to provide a smoother start to the first day of school
